#### Day 1. PIRAÑAS FISHING IN LAKE YACUMAMA OR NIGHT RIVER

##### OPTION 1: PIRAÑAS FISHING IN LAKE YACUMAMA:

Pick up at the Hotel Enai after your arrival and accommodation, we will go by road to the Santa Teresa community, a journey of approximately 20 minutes, where we will visit Lake Yacumama, a 5-minute walk will take us to the embarkation port where some canoes await us (traditional rowing boat), we will sail to the fishing area, a special area where hundreds of macaws also nest, who return to their nests at sunset creating a spectacle of sounds and colors while we fish. 6:00 PM We will return to the hotel.

Duration: 3 hours.

Attraction: Birds / Native Skills / Fishing / Photography / Astronomy / Canoe

##### OPTION 2: NIGHT RIVER:

After sunset, we will go sailing along the river searching from the boat to experience the river at night and, with a bit of luck, we will see small alligators and capybaras on the banks of the river. Being on the river at night is also a great opportunity to enjoy a breathtaking view of the stars and the moon.

Duration: 45 min.

#### Day 2. LA CACHUELA PARROT COLLPA & INKATERRA CANOPY WALKWAY EXCURSION

We will leave the Enai hotel at 5 am to travel approximately 45 minutes by boat upriver and reach the clay lick when the parrots are most active. The Cachuela clay lick is the perfect place for bird lovers to see parrots and parakeets, such as the yellow-fronted parrot, the mealy parrot, and occasionally the blue-headed macaw and other small macaws, we will continue to observe the activity of the



clay lick. of clay while they share information about the different species that visit this clay lick and enjoy the sunrise!

#### INKATERRA CANOPY WALKWAY:

Be attentive to the different birds of the jungle, such as toucans, woodpeckers, trogons, among many others ...

Day 3.- Excursion to Collpa de Loros la Cachuela or Kayak in the Madre de Dios river. Check out and return to the city.

### DETAILED ITINERARY

#### Day 1. SUNSET IN TAMBOPATA & RIO BY NIGHT

3:00 pm We will get ready to begin our adventure in the jungle enjoying a sunset in Tambopata aboard a boat, from where we will appreciate the different landscapes, surrounded by fauna that lives in the surroundings and on the banks of the rivers, we will look for the best view of the sunset while we wait for the arrival of night.

**NIGHT RIVER:** After sunset, we will return slowly searching from the boat to experience the river at night and, with a bit of luck, we will see small alligators and capybaras on the banks of the river. Being on the river at night is also a great opportunity to enjoy a breathtaking view of the stars and the moon.

Duration: 3hrs

Attractions: Sunset / alligators / astronomy / photography

#### Day 2. INKATERRA CANOPY WALK WAY EXCURSION & SANDOVAL LAKE EXCURSION- TAMBOPATA NATIONAL RESERVE

We will pick you up from the hotel at 9 am, then we will take the boat to navigate 30 minutes downstream where we will visit the INKATERRA Canopy walkway interpretation center, we will climb a 45-meter tower and we will move towards the hanging bridges to enjoy unimaginable views that only from the air They show us the life of the jungle from above, a sense of connection is revealed in this network of towers, bridges and platforms. Be attentive to the different birds of the jungle, such as toucans, woodpeckers, trogons, among many others ...

Duration: 3 hours.

Attraction: canopy / orchids / photography / birds

#### SANDOVAL LAKE- TAMBOPATA NATIONAL RESERVE:

We will have a departure at 2:00 p.m. by boat to start a half-day exploration of Lake Sandoval, one of the richest areas of animal life in the Madre de Dios region. Upon arrival at the entrance control of the National Reserve, we begin a walk of approximately 1:20 hours that will allow us to observe some of the animals that live around the lake and the great variety of trees scattered along the way.

Once we have reached the lake, we will approach the jetty to sail in a rowing canoe, through a beautiful mirror-shaped lake that is home to the river otter, as well as the red howler monkeys, macaws, prehistoric hoatzins, alligators. , different species of monkeys, turtles, a great variety of species of birds and butterflies.



We will make a stop to enjoy a snack during our exploration, once we have finished, we begin the exploration again at sunset, slowly taking the way back. Before 7:00 p.m. we will be back at the hotel.

Duration: half day, \* breakfast / snack included on the shore of the lake.

At the end of the tour we will have the opportunity to taste the derivatives of this product.
